Travel	<p>You can apply for help with travel if you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • live 1.5 miles from the college centre where your classes are/placement and • come from a household whose income is under/up to £25,000.00 or • receive the college's Progress Bursary <p>Points to Note</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) You will be asked to make a £20 contribution each term for this pass. 2) If you lose your pass, you will be required to pay £45.00 for a replacement to be issued. 3) Termly passes will only be renewed if you meet the 90% attendance requirement.
Progress Bursary	<p>To qualify for this bursary you must meet all of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aged 16-18 at the start of your course and • Attending a full study programme and • A care leaver or in care or • In receipt of Income Support or a Universal Credit in place of Income Support because you are financially supporting yourself and someone who is dependent on you and living with you such as a child or partner or • In receipt of Employment and Support Allowance or Universal Credit instead of ESA and Disability Living Allowance/Personal Independence Payment in your own name or • A young unaccompanied Asylum Seeker in one of the above groups or • A young carer <p>Payment Details</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • £30.00 per week for 36 weeks per year based on an 80% attendance requirement. • Paid directly into your bank account via BACS.
