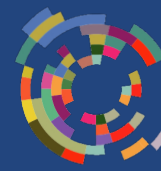

A QUICK GUIDE TO ABSENCE PROCEDURE

What should I do?	Action Required	Back to College?
If you have Covid-19 (Coronavirus) symptoms*	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You MUST NOT attend college Notify your tutor directly via email re absence Arrange to have a test You and rest of your household to isolate and await test result Inform College immediately about test result. 	When your test comes back NEGATIVE and you are symptom-free for 48 hours
If you test POSITIVE for Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You MUST NOT attend college You MUST report a positive test result to the College's Health & Safety dept. on: 0151 252 3065 or email: covid@liv-coll.ac.uk You must isolate for 10 days from onset of symptoms*, or from day of test if asymptomatic Rest of household to isolate for 14 days from day your symptoms started, or from day of test if no symptoms - <i>even if someone tests negative during those 14 days.</i> 	After self-isolation period and feeling better (<i>and have been without a fever for at least 48 hours - even if you have a cough or loss of taste/smell, as these can last for several weeks once infection has gone</i>)
Someone in your household has Covid-19 symptoms*	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You MUST NOT attend college Household member with symptoms should get a test Whole household isolates whilst waiting for test result Inform college immediately about test results. 	When household member has a NEGATIVE test result and you do not have Covid-19 symptoms*
Someone in your household has tested POSITIVE for Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You MUST NOT attend college Whole household isolates for 14 days from day symptoms* started, or from day of test if no symptoms - <i>even if someone tests negative during those 14 days.</i> 	When you've completed 14 days isolation, even if you test negative during the 14 day period
NHS Test & Trace has identified you as a 'close contact' of someone with symptoms* or confirmed Covid-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You MUST NOT attend college You must self-isolate for 14 days, as advised by NHS Test & Trace, even if you test negative during this period Rest of your household does not need to self-isolate, unless they are also a 'close contact'. 	When you've completed 14 days isolation, even if you test negative during the 14 day period

* Symptoms include at least one of the following: high temperature; new continuous cough; loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste. Find out more at:
